I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient: In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. Please designate the Particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of the new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter I 1, Section 3.)

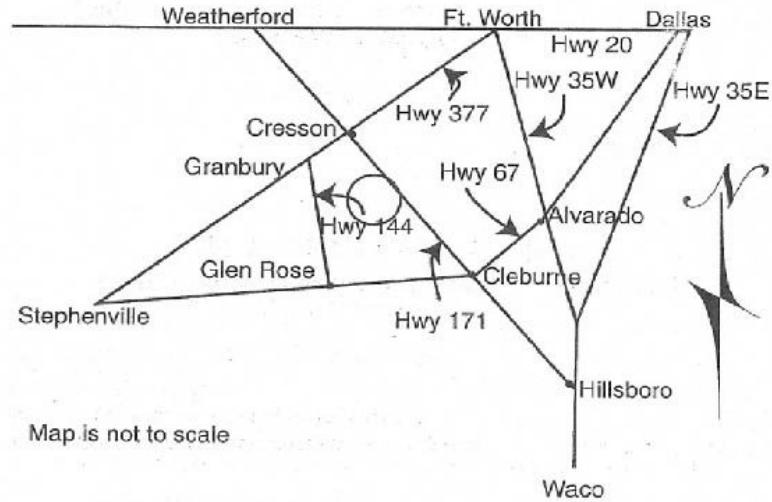

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 11:00 AM (or when site is ready) Friday, January 8, 2010. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best In Show judging on Sunday, January 10, 2010.

There will be a very limited amount of space for private x-pens IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY. These areas may or may not be under roof. All will be open air and not climate controlled.

No private sawdust may be brought in. Sawdust must be purchased from the Expo Center and is available at \$7.50 per bag. See Grooming or Grounds Chairman.

No crating, x-pens, or grooming on nursing home property across Gibbs Blvd. or along sides of roadways.

No crating or grooming on show floor. Crating must be in designated areas.

There is a limited amount of space under the bleachers in the main arena for day crating only. No dogs may be left overnight. No electricity is available in this area and electric cords may not be run from other areas.

Identification labels will be available from the Superintendent's office. Each crate should be labeled for identification in case of emergencies.

No dogs on any stairs or in elevators. No practicing allowed in rings at any time. No strollers allowed in either show arena. All children must be accompanied by an adult.

Loading and unloading at the north and west entrances in designated areas only.

The Show Committee reserves the right to stack or rearrange equipment as necessary and to remove equipment or crates left in undesignated areas.

Please be considerate of other exhibitors and use only the space needed.

All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against Nolan River Kennel Club, Trinity Valley Shetland Sheepdog Club, or its members in the event that a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

Concession stands will be open for breakfast and lunch.

The club reserves the right to cancel shows due to foul weather.

The show-giving club is not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at these shows.

There will be a New Exhibitor Briefing offered on Friday afternoon prior to judging. Check with the TVSSC Show Committee for time and location.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the fees are to be collected on the first entry only. American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). These fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show—None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. The Secretary is not able to cash checks.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Remedy must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a money order only basis.

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendents.

The show giving Club, the Show Superintendents, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.

Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Refunds of \$3.00 or less will not be issued due to the costs of processing.

An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.
